Spares—How does it Work?

If people have paid in one or more leagues they are allowed to Spare in a league if requested without having to pay the spare fee.

Those not curling in a league can spare but must join the club and pay the spare fee or \$5.00 per game using the honour system....

Skips can collect the money and place it in the suggestion box with the person's name who has spared.

League sheets should indicate those who are "Paid Spares" and who are "League Spares". If there are "Paid Spares" noted on a league roster then these spares have first right to spare and Skips are to contact them to see if they want to curl before approaching League Spares.
